Location and Time

The annual Paleoanthropology Society meeting will be held in St Louis Missouri, on Tuesday and Wednesday, April 13 and 14, in conjunction with the Society for American Archaeology in the convention hotel: Renaissance St. Louis Grand, 800 Washington Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63101. Registration will be held Tuesday morning, April 13, from 7:30 to 9:00 at the entrance to Landmark 2 and 3 where the sessions will convene. These rooms are in the hotel and not in the Convention Center where many of the SAA sessions will take place. The program will begin promptly at 9:00.

Presentation Information

Oral presentations will be strictly limited to 15 minutes, and a powerpoint projector and computer will be provided. Participants should arrive before the start of their session to load their presentations.

The poster session will take place in Landmark 1 starting at approximately 4:00 on Tuesday, April 13 and presenters should set up their material on Tuesday before that time. Spaces may be selected by the participants and will not be assigned. The poster display area per poster is 4' high x 8' wide. Mounting supplies are not provided and presenters should bring their own pushpins or double-sided tape. Electricity will not be available.
